Certification Requirements

Requirements:

- Attend for the entire duration of the course and participate during all activities.
- Successfully demonstrate the skills evaluated.

In accordance with the American Red Cross guidelines, in order for a participant be certified, the participant must demonstrate appropriate skills during the Skill Assessment activities. Attending the course does not guarantees the candidate will obtain the certification.

Courses

- First Aid CPR AED- Pediatric & Adult (and all combinations) - valid for 2 years.
- Bloodborne Pathogens - valid for 1 year.
- These are OSHA compliant training courses.
- These are NOT BLS category courses for medial field participants.

Course Pricing

Public Training

- First Aid CPR AED Adult & Pediatric \$115 per participants

Delivery Method

- Traditional Instructor Led Courses or
- Blended Courses – Online + Classroom - (Email address is required).

Course Duration

- Traditional Instructor Led Courses - It varies depending the training covered. Average of the full course First Aid CPR AED adult and Pediatric is about 6 hrs. plus 30 min. of lunch break.
- Blended Courses – Online + Classroom
Online durations is an average of 3 hrs.
Classroom duration is an average of 2 hrs. Skill Verification.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Course duration may vary and may even take longer than the average times mentioned above due to the time the participants take to demonstrate their skill competency during the activities. If a participants fails the skill assessment, the will have an opportunity, after others have been dismissed, to properly demonstrate the skill.

- All Blended Courses- English Only

Important note on Blended Courses

Participants are required to complete the entire online course portion prior the classroom session and **MUST** bring a printed copy of the Certificate of Completion, otherwise participant will not be allowed to participate in the classroom session.

If participant fails to complete the entire online portion and/or fails to attend the classroom session, the participant will be removed from the system once the course is closed and the participant will lose access to the online work and will lose all completed progress.

Site requirements for all on site company/organization requested training

- Space must accommodate all participants and allow 6ft of separation between them
- Space must accommodate the equipment (manikins etc.) with 6ft distance between them.
- Instructor will need access to the location 1hr. to 1 hr. and 30 min. before the course, depending the course (please note pediatric and AED courses require extra equipment setup)

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the blended course certificate the same as the classroom only certificate?

Yes, the certificated would not even mention the type of class the participant took. Classroom led or Blended Course will generate the same certification.

How does the blended course works?

- #1- You will received an email from the American Red Cross with your user name and instructions of how to set up a password along with the link to access the portal for the online course.
- #2- You will have missions to complete on your Online Portal. Once done, you will get a Certificate of Completion that specifies you are ready to proceed to the classroom skill assessment.
- #3- You must print and bring that Certificate of Completion to the classroom session, at the specified date and time.
- #4- Your will attend your classroom session. There you will watch videos and then practice the skill shown in the video. Once the skill assessment is successfully completed and the instructor closes the course, the participant will receive the certification via email.

When would I get my Certificate?

- You will received your certificate via email directly from the American Red Cross, if you have provided an email. This should be within 24 to 48 hrs. after completing the course via email.
- If you do not have an email, a printed copy of your certificate will me mail to you 24 to 48 hrs after your completed your class. (Please note you must allow extra days for the mail service to deliver your correspondence).
- For companies/ organizations that requested services, a printed copy of the participant's wallet cards will be mail to the company. In addition to receiving an electronic copy of all participants' certificates for their records.
